SHANKAR'S INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S COMPETITION

ON-THE-SPOT PAINTING COMPETITION 2022

1. The competition will be held on Sunday, November 20, 2022 at the I.G. Indoor Stadium, KDJWS, (ITO), I.P. Estate, New Delhi.
2. The competition will start at 10.00 a.m. and end at 1.30 p.m. Competitors are requested to be present by 9.30 a.m. No child will be admitted after 11.00 a.m.
3. Children between five and sixteen years of age (i.e., those born between November 20, 2007 and November 20, 2017 only are eligible to take part.
4. Competitors will be seated in three separate areas in the following age groups: 5-8 years, 9-12 years and 13-16 years.
5. Subjects for the different age groups will be announced at the start of the competition.
6. Competitors are requested to bring all the drawing materials they require: paper, colours, brushes, boards, and so on.
7. Paintings should preferably be in colour.
8. Competitors should give the following particulars at the back of each painting: Full name, full residential address, date of birth, mobile no. and sex.
9. The best entry in the competition will get the Shankar's Memorial Award. The three next-best entries will get the Begum Zaidi Memorial Prize, the Children's World Award, and the Children's Book Trust Award. There will be additional prizes as well.
10. Entries selected for exhibition will be given Certificates of Merit.
11. Only children will be allowed inside the venue. Parents, teachers, and other adults are requested to be seated in their designated area. Their unauthorized entry will disqualify their wards.
